DATES TO REMEMBER School Closing Early

Sensory Screening

The Southern California Sensory Screening will be at our school on **Wednesday the 10th**. They screen in four different areas including hearing, speech/language, vision and gross/fine motor. The optional screening is available for children three years and over. The cost is \$35 for any two tests or \$40 for all four tests. *Please return the attached form by Tuesday the 9th* if you would like your child to participate.

Pumpkin Patch Field Trip

Pumpkin Patch. <u>This trip is open</u> to rooms 1 and 5 only. Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult.

While at the pumpkin patch, the children will go on a train ride and a hay ride. They will have the opportunity to pick their own pumpkin from the pumpkin patch. All chaperones must submit proof of their pertussis (Tdap), measles (MMR) and 2018 flu vaccine (waiver optional), TB clearance, and sign a statement of good health.

All pumpkins will be labeled with children's names and will stay at school for the entire week to be incorporated in our curriculum. All pumpkins will be sent home after the Fall Festival, which is that Friday.
