## Kid's Night Out

Kid's Night Out is **Friday the 15<sup>th</sup> from 6-11pm.** This is an opportunity for you, the parents, to go out while your children are having a blast at school. **This event is open to children 3 months through 10 years.** The cost for children 2 and up is \$35 per child and \$20 for siblings. The cost for infants is \$55. Please note we must have a minimum of 10 children to have the event for the preschool age children and a minimum of 3 infants to have the event for infants. **The last day to sign up is Wed. the 13<sup>th</sup>.** 

#### **Environmental Nature Center**

is our trip to Environmental Nature Center. This trip is open to rooms 1, 3, and 5 only. Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult.

Environmental Nature Center is located in Newport Beach. On the trip, children will take a hike through the center as they discuss the life cycle of frogs, touch a real, live toad, discuss the life cycle of butterflie,s and visit the butterfly house (seasonal). Children will discuss snakes and how they shed their skin to grow, examine snakeskin with magnifying lenses and get to meet a real, live snake. The children will also discuss that mammals have fur to keep them warm when it's cold, and gently touch the fur of several local animals. Children will also listen to a story under the shade of an oak tree.
