<u>DATES TO REMEMBER</u> Irvine Park Pumpkin Patch Field Trip

Monday, October 10th is our trip to Irvine Park Pumpkin Patch. <u>This trip is open to rooms 1, 3, and 5 only.</u> Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult. Irvine Park is located in Irvine, California. While at the pumpkin patch, the children will go on a train ride and a hay ride. They will have the opportunity to pick their own pumpkin from the pumpkin patch.

All pumpkins will be labeled with children's names and will stay at school for the entire week, so we can incorporate them in our curriculum. All pumpkins will be sent home after the Fall Festival, which is that Friday.

The cost is \$22/child and \$15/adult (adult chaperone space is limited on the bus). To sign up: pay and pick up a permission slip from the office by Wednesday, October 5th. Payment can be made by check, cash or by using your Tuition Express account.

Fall Festival

Friday the 14th from 4:30 to 6:00pm, is our Fall Festival. The evening will be filled with fun family activities.

Families are invited to bring a pumpkin to decorate. We will have collage materials available. If your child attends the Irvine Park Pumpkin Patch field trip, they will already have their pumpkin at school!

During the week the children will be making a "Friendship Soup" for the event. Children will be preparing vegetables for the soup, to be enjoyed during the festival.

Reminder, children must be sign out and accompanied by a parent/authorized person in order to participate in the event.

Please note we must have a minimum of 10 children to have the event for the preschool age children and a minimum of 4 infants to have the event for infants.

<u>Parent/Teacher Conferences</u>

Our Conference days will be November 1st through 10th. Parents will have the chance to meet with your child's teacher, share ideas and find out what your child enjoys most about school. This conference is for parents only, and no childcare is available (unless your child is enrolled that day)

Sign-up sheets will be on a clipboard on the sign in and out table starting **Monday the 10**th. Please try to keep your appointment, rescheduling may not be possible. We hope everyone can make it.

Fall pictures will be on **Tuesday the 25th** and **Wednesday the 26th**. Pictures will start around 8:30 and follow this order, Room 8, 9, 7, 3, 1 and 5.

Children who are in rooms 8, 9 & 7 and attend school **five days a week** will take their pictures on **Tuesday**.

Children who are in rooms 3, 1 & 5 and attend school **five days a week** will take their pictures on **Wednesday**.

Please send your child to school wearing the outfit you would like them to be photographed in, and we will change them after they have taken their picture.

In order for your child to be photographed, they must have a completed Portrait Permission Form filled out to have pictures taken on these days. Sorry, the form cannot be emailed as it is a carbon copy form. Please stop by the office the next time you are at the school to complete the form.

Parents will have the opportunity to view, purchase (no obligation) and take your child's pictures home on **Tuesday 11/8** from 3:00-6:00pm & **Wednesday 11/9** from 11:30-12:15 and from 3:00-6:00pm.
