Field Trip Environmental Nature Center

XXXXX is our trip to Environmental Nature Center. This trip is open to rooms 1, 3, 5, and 6 only. Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult.

Environmental Nature Center is located in Newport Beach. On the trip children will take a hike through the center, discuss the life cycle of frogs and touch a real live toad. Children will discuss snakes, examine snakeskin with magnifying lenses and get to meet a snake. Children will also listen to a story under the shade of an oak tree.

REMINDERS Program Hours

We are governed by the Department of Social Services and we are required to follow strict guidelines regarding ratio. We staff teachers according to our enrollment in order to meet these ratios.

- * Half day program starts at 8:45am and ends at 11:45am.
- *Core program starts between 8:30am and ends at 3:00pm.

Children may not arrive before or stay after their programs scheduled times without prior arrangement with the office. Extra hours are available upon request and based on availability. Please see office staff for more information.

Parking and Drop offs

* The front drive way is for quick three (3) minute drop offs. Please pull all the way forward and to one side. If

you want to stay and play with your child, please park in the front 20 minute parking on the street in front of the school, along the street or in the back parking lot. Please do not block the driveway or back parking lot.

- * Reminder, do not park on the street Thursday mornings due to street sweeping.
- * Your child needs a complete set of weather appropriate clothes in their cubby (jacket, pants, etc), diapers & wipes if needed, and an emergency kit.
- * Children go outside each day. When the weather is cool, please make sure children have appropriate clothing and a jacket available.
