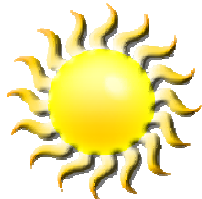


## FRIENDLY REMINDERS

- Children go outside each day. Please, check to see that your child's "extra clothes" are weather appropriate. Borrowed items must be washed and returned promptly.
- Don't forget to put sun block on your child daily before bringing them to school.
- We do have water activities for the children in the morning, as well as the afternoon. If you have an appointment or an errand to run after picking your child up, please let a staff member know so we can have your child ready.
- No outside food is allowed at our center, unless prearranged by the office. Breakfast is not served by the center. Children need to arrive at school physically ready for the day, which includes having eaten a nutritious breakfast. We allow parents to bring in a nutritious breakfast for children arriving before 7:30am. Please remember, that we are a peanut free school; therefore, no peanut products are allowed.
