REMINDERS

- * Your child needs a complete set of clothes in their cubby, diapers & wipes (if applicable) and an emergency kit.
- * If you are a returning family, it's time to take home your child's emergency kit to be restocked for the year. (Please see the attached handout)
- * Please, stop by the office to verify that your emergency information is up to date.

PARKING REMINDERS

We understand that morning drop off can be a little hectic with our limited parking; therefore, it is imperative that everyone observes and follows the parking guidelines below to allow a smooth morning transition.

- The front drive way is for quick three
 (3) minute drop offs and pickups, especially during the 8:15-9:00am and the 2:30-3:00pm busy times.
- When parking in the front drive way please, pull all the way forward and to one side. This will allow for cars to pass as needed.
- If you want to stay and play with your child, please park in the front 20 minute parking on the street or in the back parking lot.
- When parking in the back or front, please do not block the large white gate to the parking lot or block the drive way itself.
- One last reminder, street sweeping is on Thursday mornings, so do not park on the street in the morning hours. Parking will be especially hectic on this day, plan accordingly.

Irvine Park Pumpkin Patch Field Trip

XXXXX is our trip to Irvine Park Pumpkin Patch. <u>This trip is open to rooms 1, 3 and 5 only.</u> Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult. Irvine Park is located in Irvine, California. While at the pumpkin patch, the children will go on a train ride and a hay ride. They will have the opportunity to pick their own pumpkin from the pumpkin patch.

All pumpkins will be labeled with children's names and will stay at school for the entire week, so we can incorporate them in our curriculum. All pumpkins will be sent home after the Fall Festival, which is that Friday.

The cost is \$17/child and \$10/adult (adult chaperone space is limited on the bus). Signups will start the week of September 16th.
