REMINDERS Program Hours

We are governed by the Department of Social Services (DSS) and we are required to follow strict guidelines regarding ratio. We staff teachers according to our enrollment in order to meet these ratios.

* Half day program starts at 8:45am and ends at 11:45am.

*Core program starts between 8:30am and 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm.

Parking and Drop offs

* The front drive way is for quick three (3) minute drop offs. Please pull all the way forward and to one side. If you want to stay and play with your child, please park in the front 20 minute parking on the street in front of the school, along the street or in the back parking lot. Please do not block the driveway or back parking lot.

* Reminder, do not park on the street Thursday mornings due to street sweeping.
