Parking and Drop offs

- * The front drive way is for quick three (3) minute drop offs. Please pull all the way forward and to one side. If you want to stay and play with your child, please park in the front 20 minute parking on the street in front of the school, along the street or in the back parking lot. Please do not block the driveway or back parking lot.
- *please drive slowly when pulling into the front driveway or in the back parking lot.
- * Reminder, do not park on the street Thursday mornings due to street sweeping.

BIRTHDAYS AND OTHER CELEBRATIONS

We allow you to celebrate your child's birthday or special occasion at the center with a nutritious snack. Please let the teacher know a week in advance. The following are acceptable nutritious suggestions for the birthday snack: fruit, pudding, yogurt (make fruit sundaes), muffins, 100% fruit popsicles, bagels with flavored cream cheese, frozen yogurt pushups.

Families are allowed and encouraged to come and make a special treat with the children (must be pre-arranged with classroom and office team). Cupcakes, donuts, cakes are not allowed for birthday snack. Treats brought to the school must be commercially prepared, NOT HOME MADE. No nut products allowed. All special event items must go through the office for approval before being served or given to the children. See your child's teacher or office staff for suggestions. Please know that under no circumstance will candy be allowed to be distributed to children (goodie bags, valentines etc.)
