### Pretend City Field Trip

**Tuesday the 28<sup>th</sup>** is our field trip to the Pretend City. This trip is open to rooms 1, 3, and 5 only. Pretend City Children's Museum features a small, interconnected city designed to "build better brains" through purposeful play, hands-on learning experiences and role playing. Through 17 interactive exhibits and activities, children learn foundational math, reading and science skills, while fostering curiosity, creativity, critical thinking, problem solving, organization, teamwork, self-confidence and socialization.

The cost of the trip is \$16/child or adult chaperone. To sign up: pay and pick up a permission slip from the office by **Thursday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>**. Payment can be made by check, cash or using your Tuition Express account.

Children go outside each day. Please, check to see that your child's "extra clothes" are weather appropriate. An extra set of shoes is always nice.

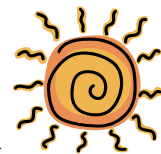
