## REMINDERS Water Activities

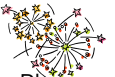


As the weather permits, we will start having water activities for the children in the morning as well as the afternoon. If you have an appointment or an errand to run after picking up your child, please let a staff member know, so we can have your child ready.

### Sunscreen

Don't forget to apply sunscreen in the morning before dropping your child off at school and think of protective clothes for your child, especially the ones with very fair skin.

### Parking and Drop offs



\* The front driveway is for quick 3 minute drop offs. Please pull all the way forward and to one side. If you want to stay and play with your child, please park in the front 20 minute parking on the street in front of the school, along the street or in the back parking lot. Please do not block the driveway or back parking lot.

\*Street sweeping is on Thursday mornings, so do not park on the street in the morning hours. To assist with parking challenges, we are bringing back quick-drop off from 8:45am-9am. (See attached handout).

### Program Hours



We are governed by the Department of Social Services (DSS) and we are required to follow strict guidelines regarding ratio. We staff teachers according to our enrollment in order to meet these ratios:

- \* Half day program starts at 8:45am and ends at 11:45am.
- \* Core program starts between 8:30am and 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm.

Children may not arrive before or stay after their programs' scheduled times without prior arrangement with the office. Extra hours are available upon request and based on availability. Please see office staff for more information and the Parent Handbook for fees related to late pick-ups.
