Read for the Record

On **Thursday October 27th**, children and adults worldwide, including Children's Village, will participate in the world's largest shared reading experience by reading this year's campaign book, *The Bear Ate your Sandwich*, by Julia Sarcone-Roach.

It is a tale of a bear lost in the city who happens upon an unattended sandwich in the park. The bear's journey from forest to city and back home again is full of happy accidents, funny encounters, and sensory delights. The story is so engrossing it's not until the very end, when we discover the narrator is a shaggy dog, that we begin to suspect this is a TALL tale.

"Read for the Record" is a global campaign that generates public support for high-quality early learning and highlights the importance of building children's vocabulary and love of reading.

We will attempt to break the world reading record (again!) for the most people reading the same book on the same day. Last year, Children's Village Preschool and over 2.2 million participants read *Not Norman*: A Goldfish Story, creating the world's largest shared reading experience!
