<u>Referral Reminder</u>

- 1. \$100 tuition credit to the referring family for each referral that pays the registration fee and at least one month's tuition.

Other Important Reminders

- * We are running low on plastic bags. We use them daily for wet or soiled clothing. You can help us by supplying your child with a reusable bag for dirty clothes or for those that shop at any stores that distribute free plastic bags, please consider saving those and donating them to the school.
- *Nap time items: We want your children to be successful in self-help skills, so we encourage them to assist in getting their clothes, their sheet and blanket, and other items from their cubby. Because of this, we ask that you help us in making sure that their cubby is not too full. Please limit naptime items to a fitted crib sheet and a blanket (no pillows please).
