# **PARKING REMINDERS**

We understand that drop off and pick up can be a little hectic with our limited parking, especially during the 8:15-9:00am and the 2:30-3:00pm busy times; therefore, it is imperative that everyone observes and follows the parking guidelines below to allow for a smooth morning drop off and afternoon pick-up.

- When parking in the front driveway, please pull all the way forward and parking <u>straight</u> to one side. This will allow for cars to pass as needed.
- The front driveway is for quick drop offs and pickups only.
- If you want to touch base with the office or your child's teacher, please park in the front 20-minute parking on the street (except Thursdays due to street sweeping in the morning) or in the back-parking lot.
- When parking in the back or front, please do not block the large white gate to the parking lot or block the driveway itself.
- Street sweeping is on Thursday mornings, so do not park on the street in the morning hours.
- Observe colored curb zones that are painted to indicate parking prohibition and restrictions. Parking in the red creates unsafe blind spots for other drivers.

# **REFERRAL REMINDER**

- 1. \$100 tuition credit to the referring family for each referral that pays the registration fee and at least one month's tuition.
- 2. For new parents who enroll, we will apply their paid registration fee to their first month tuition, saving them \$140.
