LOOKING AHEAD IN DECEMBER Kid's Night Out

Kid's Night Out will be on Friday, December 20th from 6-11pm. This is an opportunity for you, the parents, to go out while your children are having a blast at school. This event is open to children from 3 months through 6 years. The cost for children 2 and up is \$40 per child and \$30 for siblings. The cost for infants is \$60.
