DATES TO REMEMBER

Best Buddy Ice Cream

In honor of Father's Day, we invite dads or a dad representative (uncle, grandfather, etc.), one adult per child, to come on **Thursday**, **June 12th** and enjoy ice cream with your child. The event will be from 3:00-4:30pm. Children must be signed out before joining their parent/guardian at the event.

Therefore, as a reminder, the adult accompanying your child to the event must have authorization to sign your child out prior to participating in the event. Children will be in the yard and are encouraged to wash their hands before escorting you to the event. See event parking guidelines below.

TK Graduation

The TK graduation is for children attending kindergarten in the Fall of 2025. Graduation will be on **Friday**, **June 13th @ 9:30am**; arrival time will be between 9:00-9:15am. The ceremony will be on the lawn, so please bring lawn chairs or blankets. **Let us know if your child will be leaving right after the ceremony so we can plan accordingly. See event parking guidelines below.**

Our annual sing-along will be on **Friday**, **June 13th starting at 5:00pm**. We welcome you to join in the fun by bringing your dinner and chairs or blankets. Please plan extra time for event parking. The front driveway is for quick three (3) minute drop offs and pickups; therefore, if you will be attending any of the events above, please parkin the back parking lot or along the side wall (please do not block white gate), or on the street.

Kids' Night Out

Kids' Night Out is on **Friday the 20th from 6-10:45pm.** This is an opportunity for you, the parents, to go out while your children are having a blast at school. **This event is open to children from 3 months through 6 years.** The cost for children 2 and up is \$50 per child and \$40 for enrolled siblings. The cost for infants is \$60. We must have a minimum of 10 children to have the event for the preschool age children and 3 infants to have the event for infants. **Space is limited and availability is granted on a first come, first served basis. Please sign up by Wednesday, June 18th.**

Mud Day

On **Friday**, **June 27th**, we will be participating in the International Mud Day Celebration sponsored by the World Forum Foundation. To be prepared for the event, please send your child to school with their bathing suits under their clothes, a towel, and a change of clothes. – **Don't forget to apply sunblock before dropping off!**

CLASSROOM TRANSITIONS

Children who are eligible to move to their next classoom will have "visiting days" **as openings occur between June through September**. The length of visits will depend on each child; sometimes a day is all they need! Teachers will let you know of their progress. You will be notified when your child is scheduled to move up.
