# **WELCOME**

Welcome to the 2025-2026 school year! The sun is still shining brightly, but fall is just around the corner. It is time to get back into your school schedule. This means getting children up, feeding them a nutritious breakfast, and getting to school by 9:00am.

The children transition from the yard to the classroom at 9:00am. Once they arrive in the classroom, children wash their hands for snack, which is served promptly after. To make the transition smoother for your child, please avoid dropping them off during the 9:00am transition time. Arriving a little earlier will help ensure that teachers can greet and settle your child in. If children arrive after snack has been cleaned up, they will miss out on this important nutritional and engaging activity.

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated! Remember preschool is a wonderful opportunity to set up good school habits.

## **HEALTH REMINDERS**

It is important that the children in our program stay healthy. We are not licensed to care for ill children, and we depend on you to keep ill children at home. If your child is out for any health reasons (illnesses/communicable diseases), please notify the school as soon as possible.

Authorized representatives must conduct home self-evaluations prior to bringing children to the center.

# PICK-UP GRACE PERIODS

Each program includes a 15-minute grace period before the final pick-up time, by which all children, including siblings, must be signed out and physically in the parent/guardian's care: 11:45am for the half day program, 3pm for Core Day and 6pm for Full Day. For Full Day families, this means being completely off the premises, including the parking lot, by 6pm.

<u>The grace period is not the expected pickup time; it is the latest allowable time.</u> All children must be fully picked up from their classrooms by the end of the grace period.

# **CUBBY BOXES**

All items must fit inside your child's cubby. We suggest parents bring a <u>labeled</u> pillowcase or reusable bag to transport children's belongings. Please refrain from putting any type of lotion, hand sanitizer, sunscreen, or diaper ointment in their cubbies. These items <u>cannot</u> be administered without the proper forms and must be stored in the office. Items that do not fit in their cubby box will be sent home.

# <u>DATES TO REMEMBER</u> Meet & Greet Event

On Wednesday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, the school will be closing at 4pm for our monthly staff development, and from 5:15 to 5:45pm, there will be a **parent/guardian only** Meet & Greet.

This is an opportunity for parents/guardians to talk with teachers and with other parents, meet the teaching team, tour your child's classroom, and get information about your child's classroom. Our Meet & Greet is for adults only.

The school will be closing at 4pm; therefore, childcare will not be offered.

## <u>Irvine Regional Park Fieldtrip</u>

The preschool children will be going to Irvine Regional Park Pumpkin Patch \*\*\*! This field trip is open to **Rooms 5 and 1**. Each child who attends the trip will receive a pumpkin, which will stay at the school until the Fall Festival. **All children must have fully mastered the potty learning process, unless accompanied by an adult.** While at the pumpkin patch, the children will go on a train ride, pick out their pumpkin, and go on a hayride.

All chaperones must submit proof of their pertussis (Tdap), measles (MMR), 2025 flu vaccine (waiver available), and TB test (dated within the last year), and sign a statement of good health and chaperone agreement (forms available in the office) by Monday, October 13th. If interested, don't wait, start collecting documents now. Chaperone space is on a first come first go basis.
